

## PREPARATION

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1. Select the sight words flashcards for the level you would like to use.
2. From the Lesson Plans page within the Resource Center, print the Bingo cards for that level.
3. As students play they need to track which words have been called. This can be accomplished in a number of different ways. Here are two of them:
  - #1 - Students can write directly on the cards. This provides for limited reuse of cards.
  - #2 - You can laminate the cards and have the students use erasable marker.

## EXECUTION

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1. Distribute a unique bingo card to each student.
2. Randomly select a flashcard from the set you are using and read it out loud.
3. Every student that has that word on his or her card marks their card accordingly.
4. Continue until a student has completed a row across, down or diagonal (or any shape you choose) at which point they shout "Bingo!"
5. Have the student(s) read the words that make up their bingo to check for accuracy.
