

PREPARATION

1. Select the sight words flashcards you would like to use for the game. There should be one word for each student that is playing.
2. You will need two copies of each card kept in separate piles, the player's pile and the teacher's pile.

EXECUTION

1. Give one card from the player's pile to each student and have the students stand up.
2. Begin the game by selecting a card at random from the teacher's pile and reading it out loud.
3. The student with the player copy of that card reads it out loud and sits down. They have been "knocked out".
4. Repeat until only one player remains. That player is the winner.

Variation #1: When you select and read a card from the teacher pile, you may want to have the entire class repeat after you, not just the student with the card. Additionally, you may want to spell the word with your students.

Variation #2: You can also play a team version where each team selects a certain number of cards from the player's pile and they manage those cards as a group. Once all of their cards are called, the whole team is "knocked out"

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
