

# MEMORY MATCH

SIGHT WORDS LESSON PLAN



## PREPARATION

1. Determine which words you would like to use within the Memory Match game.
2. Make sure you have two copies of each flashcard for the selected words.

## EXECUTION

1. This game can be played by two or more individual students or by students playing on teams.
2. The players review each of the selected flashcards and place them face down on a desk or table.
3. The first player turns over one card and then attempts to turn over the match of that card.
4. If that student correctly selects a matching pair, he or she keeps those cards and their turn continues.
5. If that student does not select a matching pair, he or she turns the flipped cards back over and the turn ends.
6. The players or teams alternate until all the cards have been matched. The player or team with the most cards wins.

Variation: A version of Memory Match can also be played as a teacher led classroom activity. See the lesson plan for Sight Words Recall for details.
