

## PREPARATION

1. Select the sight words flashcards you would like to use for the game.
2. Write those words down or print out a list for your reference.
3. Review the selected words with your students by reading each word out loud and showing them the flashcard.

## EXECUTION

1. Divide the students into two teams and select a designated “flipper” for each team.
2. Review the selected flashcards a second time by reading each one out loud and placing it face down on a table or hanging it on the board with the blank side facing out.
3. Instruct the students to attempt to remember where each word is being placed.
4. Once you have gone through all the cards, read a word from your reference list.
5. Team 1 selects the card they think has that word on it and their “flipper” turns that card over.
6. If they selected the right card, they get to keep it.
7. If they selected the wrong word, read the word out loud and return it to its original position.
8. Team 2 goes next and then each team takes turns until all of the cards are gone.  
At the end of the game, the team with the most cards wins.
